Strategic International Connectivity: Iran's geographical location has positioned it as a vital hub for connecting various countries, transforming it into a global trade and transportation crossroads.

Natural Resources and Diverse Production: Iran's abundance of natural resources, along with its wide range of agricultural, mineral, and oil products, provides a unique advantage for exports and economic development.

Blue Economy Potential: With 190,000 square kilometres of marine territory and 5,800 kilometres of coastline in the north and south, Iran offers unparalleled opportunities to develop a thriving blue economy.

Investment in Energy Industries: Iran represents one of the most significant opportunities for energy sector investors, with a potential investment of \$600 billion in the oil, gas, refining, and petrochemical sectors.

Free Trade Zones (FTZs): Iran's establishment of Free Trade Zones (FTZs) and Special Economic Zones (SEZs) provides significant business incentives, offering benefits such as tax exemptions and customs duty relief.





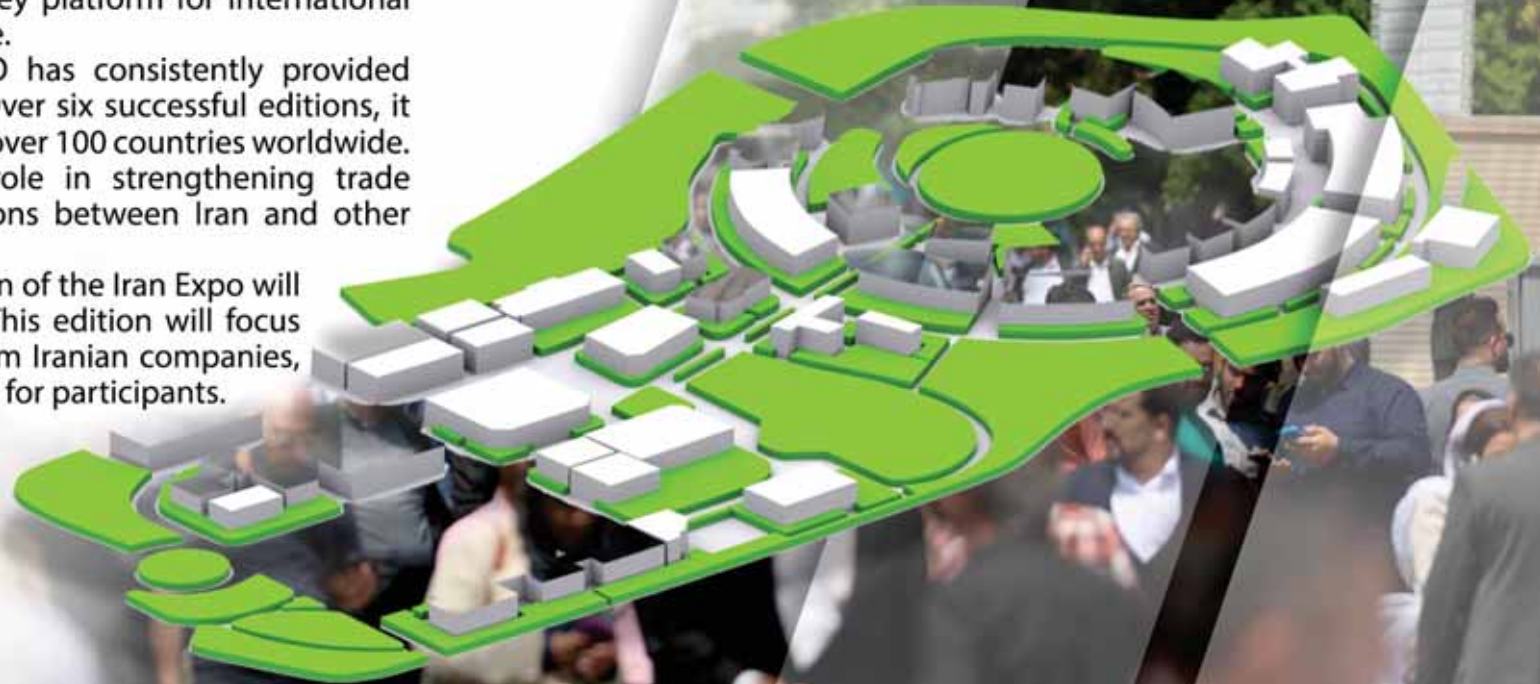

- The largest producer of dates, pistachios, honey, and walnuts in the world.
- Iran is the second-largest caviar producer and the world's largest producer of rainbow trout.
- Exports of fishery products to 66 countries worldwide amount to 1.3 million tons, valued at over \$600 million.
- Iran is the second-largest producer of raisins and a major producer of apples, oranges, and pomegranates.

- Among the top 5 producers of chandeliers and decorative lights in the world, with \$200 million in annual exports.
- Iran has a significant share in the production of transformers, generators, and control systems for the oil, gas, and renewable energy industries in the region.

- Iran's handwoven carpet exports reach over 100 countries, with these carpets enjoying a steady customer base in global markets, particularly in the United States, Europe, and the Gulf countries.
- Iran, with over 350 different handicraft categories in various fields such as pottery, carpet weaving, jewellery making, filigree work, felt making, marquetry, and leatherwork and etc, is one of the richest countries in terms of handicrafts.
- Additionally, with its historical, cultural, natural, and religious attractions, Iran is one of the popular tourist destinations in the region. Places such as Shiraz, Isfahan, Yazd, Kashan, and Tabriz are among the most popular tourist destinations in the country.
